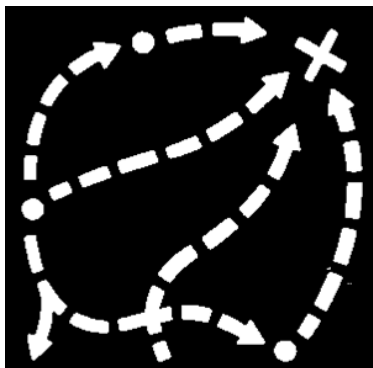


Farmer Discussion Groups: Agriculture Business Management in an Inflationary Economy Available In Person and via Zoom—you choose!
