The workshop was called to order by Supervisor Lefkaditis, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

- The estimates for the CEC grant were discussed.
- Solar Liberty submitted an estimate for the solar array via email quoting 3.04 cents/watt for a 40kW array; not located near 3 phase power
- National Solar Technologies quoted 2.32 cents/watt located next to 3 phase power.
- With every grant you must have legal right to the property or own it outright
- A request was submitted for an 18-month extension, but no response back
- Other property is being considered that would need to go through a permissive referendum
- A project execution plan must be completed with site and details
- An estimate of ball field light usage needs to be created
- The pavilion electricity will also be upgraded
- Type of solar panels need to be specified
- If new property or the old dump property are not available then the property behind the ball field will be used
- Plan A would be the potential new property, Plan B would be the old landfill and Plan C would be behind the ball field. The first steps are getting the environmental reports for the landfill and to find out if the extension has been granted.
