Suggested donation of \$5/person or \$20/family. Please bring non-perishable food items for a food pantry donation.

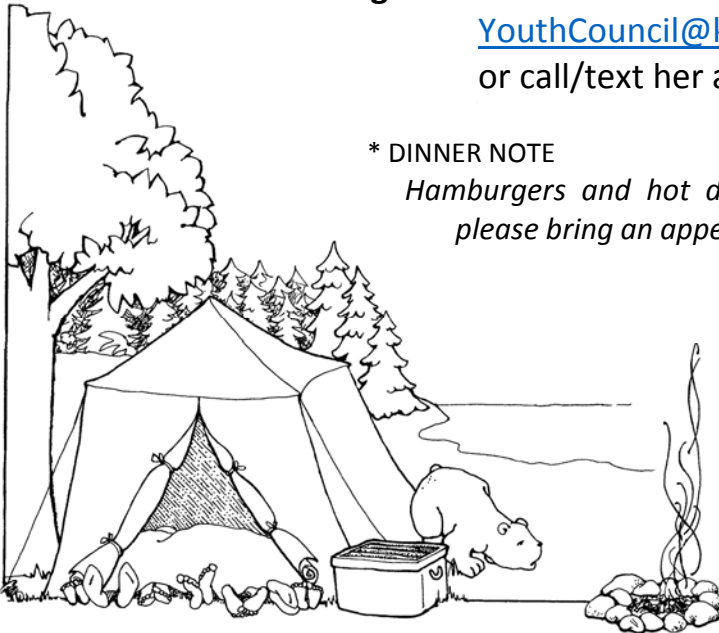

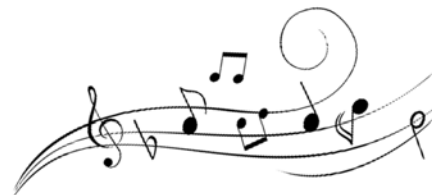
