Supervisor Hammond discussed with the board members the possibility of the town owning a propane tank or having a tank supplied by a propane delivery company. The cost of a 500 gallon tank would be \$1,750 or a 1,000 gallon tank would be \$2,200, and if the town owned their own tank, the town would be able to purchase the propane from a company that is cheaper. Councilman Decker received prices for a 500 gallon tank it would be \$1,380 and for a 1,000 gallon tank it would be \$2,050. Town Attorney Dorfman suggests

that Supervisor Hammond speak with the town's insurance carrier before any decision is made.

Supervisor Hammond read to the board two correspondence that he received.
